CLEVELAND – Today, The Cleveland Orchestra announced details of the third season of *In Focus*, its digital streaming concert series on <u>adella.live</u> and the Adella digital streaming app, as well as a new partnership with <u>Symphony</u>.

In Focus Season 3

Following the successful launch in 2020 of fifteen episodes in Season 1, and another six episodes in Season 2 in 2021 *In Focus*, Season 3 includes ten new episodes premiering from October to June. Details of *In Focus* Season 3 programs are included in the Calendar Listing and Program Information section below.

With funding from the Jack, Joseph and Morton Mandel Foundation, the Orchestra completed an ambitious upgrade to its video recording capabilities in Mandel Concert Hall at Severance Music Center. The upgrade allows for expanded access to The Cleveland Orchestra across the globe by investing in digital infrastructure and providing audiences with increased program and content choices through the
